Course Description: Today's sectional overhead doors are more sophisticated than ever. Options include high-strength glazing for security and insulated steel sections for increased energy efficiency and durability. Code requirements for safety in high wind-load areas, impact resistance to hurricanes, and reductions in air transmission have led to improvements in door technology and hardware. This course examines a range of safety and security options for architects to consider when designing and specifying sectional overhead doors.

Identify a range of safety and security options to consider when specifying this door type, including entrapment safety devices.
Explore door section design and installation, including track lift types, spring options, and safety hardware, as well as wind-load design.
